requirements, reminders and suggestions

Remember! You are looking for a story from your interviewee on the theme of time. Their story should be interesting, personal and have some level of emotion.

Requirements:

- Your full interview should be **5-10 minutes long**
- Your edited interview should be **about 2 minutes long**
- Your full in-between shot should be **about 1 minute long**
- Your edited in-between shot should be **20-30 seconds long**

A few reminders:

1. Thank your interviewee at the beginning and end of your interview
2. Let your interviewee know how long the interview should take (no longer than 10 minutes - watch your time!)
3. Don't talk over your interviewee
4. Give your interviewee a second or two of silence in case they want to add something
5. Comment on your interviewee's responses and ask follow-up questions

Potential interview questions

- Time has a different meaning for everyone. What does time mean to you?
- How do you make time for (your family, all of your classes, your ECA, etc.)....?
- Can you tell me about a time that was very (emotional, overwhelming, difficult, etc.)...?
- Can you talk about a time when you didn't manage your time well?
- What is your favourite way to spend your time at CVR?
- What do you do with your time when you aren't at CVR?
- Is there a difference between how you spend your time at CVR and at home?
- Have you ever had a major event that helped you realize the importance of time?
- Would you say that you use your time wisely?
- How do you understand time now, as compared to when you were younger?
- Do you ever feel overwhelmed by how little time you have to do something?
- You've been at CVR for some time now, (what has changed for you, what do you enjoy now that you didn't then, how are you different now from back then)...
